The state of Virginia requires us to keep updated health records for each child that attends our program. We are



required to get an updated shot record every 6 months. To make it a little easier on our end, we collect shot records all at one time in September and March. This helps us make sure we are always up to date! If you are enrolled for summer, this will cover you until Fall semester. If you are not, we will still need an updated shot record for your child to continue attending KMO through this Spring Semester. ***We do not need the whole health form again, just the updated shot record!*** You can have your doctor print it for you to bring in, or send it straight to us via fax (757-229-1223, Attn: Laura Pittman) or e-mail (lpittman@williamsburgumc.org). Whatever you prefer!! We would like to have these done as soon as possible, so the earlier the better.
